This dreadfully sad and powerful documentary meets Mina Smallman, the mother of Bibaa Henry and Nicole Smallman, sisters who were brutally murdered in a London park in June 2020 while celebrating Bibaa's birthday. We see again those haunting images, taken on a

those haunting images, taken on a mobile phone, of the women looking so happy together, dancing in the sunshine. Then, we're reminded that police officers at the scene desecrated their memories by taking photos of their bodies and distributing them.

Mina, the Church of England's first black female Archdeacon, talks to Stacey Dooley as her faith guides her through the shock and loss. She also has brave questions to ask - of the

police, and us – about the deaths of her daughters, and the aftermath.
